### Weather Forecast Valid For 120 Hours Commencing 06 PM of 25.04.2025:

Synoptic Situation: Trough of low lies over West Bengal to North Bay across Southwestern part of Bangladesh.

## Day-1 (commencing 06 PM of 25.04.2025):

**Rainfall:** Rain/thunder showers with lightning flashes and temporary gusty wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Mymensingh & Sylhet divisions. Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country.

Heat Wave: Mild to moderate heat wave is sweeping over Rajshahi division and the districts of Dinajpur, Jashore and Chuadanga and it may continue.

**Temperature:** Day and night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

Wind direction and speed at Dhaka : West/Northwesterly (08-12) kph.

RH at 06 P.M. of Dhaka : 65 %
Tomorrow's sunset at Dhaka : 06-25 PM
Tomorrow's sunrise at Dhaka : 05-28AM

#### Day-2 (commencing 06 PM of 26.04.2025):

Rainfall: Rain/thunder showers with lightning flashes and temporary gusty wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Rangpur, Mymensingh & Sylhet divisions. Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country.

**Temperature:** Day and night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

## Day 3 (commencing 06 PM of 27.04.2025):

Rainfall: Rain/thunder showers with lightning flashes and temporary gusty wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Rangpur, Rajshahi, Dhaka, Mymensingh, Khulna, Barishal, Chattogram & Sylhet divisions.

**Temperature:** Day temperature may fall by (2-3)° C and night temperature may fall slightly over the country.

# Day 4 (commencing 06 PM of 28.04.2025):

Rainfall: Rain/thunder showers with lightning flashes and temporary gusty wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Rangpur, Rajshahi, Dhaka, Mymensingh, Khulna & Sylhet divisions. Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country.

**Temperature:** Day and night temperature may rise slightly over the country.

## Day 5 (commencing 06 PM of 29.04.2025):

Rainfall: Rain/thunder showers with lightning flashes and temporary gusty wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Dhaka, Khulna, Barishal, Chattogram & Sylhet divisions. Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country.

**Temperature:** Day and night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

Outlook for next 05 (five) days: Rain/thunder showers activity may continue.
