#### Terms of Reference for selection consultancy Firm for Preparation of project success story with video documentary Package No: AMISDP SD 023

#### A. Background

The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of Agro-Meteorological Information Systems Development Project [Component — C of Bangladesh Weather and Climate Services Regional Project (BWCSRP)] to be implemented by Department of Agricultural Extension (DAE) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for the provision of services for the project by hiring of a firm for Preparation of project success story with video documentary

One of the primary objectives of the project is to generate agrometeorological advisories for the farmers of Bangladesh to inform them about upcoming adverse weather, pest and disease incidences so that they can undertake enough precautionary measures. In addition to this the project provides advisories on time planting, harvesting and fertilization and its dissemination to the farming community. The project works closely with the Bangladesh Meteorological Board (BMD) and Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) to generate the advisories.

To disseminate these advisories, the project is uses a multi-channel dissemination system. Among others, the AMISDP works with 30,000 lead farmers and farmers leaders to disseminate this information in the field. It also sends this advisory to the Upazila-level offices of the Department of Agricultural Extension. It also leverages several ICT-based mediums to disseminate this information to farmer-level. In addition to that preparation and display of video documentaries may be considered as important activities for the efficient outreach of the agromet advisories for better farm management.

The main objective of the assignment is to document AMISDP achievements and success stories in print, photography, audio and video as per the demand of the -beneficiaries of its services. The outputs from the case studies shall highlight the achievements registered by AMISDP during the last five years of operational Agromet Advisory Services in the country. The outputs will be shared with various target groups, including stakeholders, and current and potential donors to showcase the impact of the organization's work and to mobilize more resources to fund its ever-growing operations in project area. The assignment also aims at demonstrating project success and impact including the review and collection all facts and figures about all the application of the services and how the services useful for extreme event on crop, livestock, poultry, and fisheries. Assignments also include collection of feedback from the community on the merits of project services. Visualization of the different impacts of this service to user community for upscaling upazilla and block level would be also the part of the assignment.

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### B. Objectives:

The main objective of the assignment is to capture project success through video documentaries and success stories, showing the impact of project interventions on the agriculture sector of Bangladesh as well as the different impacts on user communities.

- More specifically, the consultant shall design and prepare 67 video documentaries and a book with success stories (including photos) highlighting aspects such as:
  - Impacts of Agromet advisory service such as Crops, Livestock, Poultry, Fisheries etc.
  - Impacts of SMS, IVR and Media service.
  - Impacts of Digital Display Board, Automatic Weather station, Community radio, Automatic Rain Gauge & union level Agromet Display Board etc. service.
  - Impact of extreme weather advisories
  - The impact of the Agromet advisory generation and dissemination media, the collaboration, and/or findings/results/ with the Agromet. department of universities, research agencies, and even the agromet generation mechanism should also be highlighted.

#### C. Scope of services:

To achieve this goal, the consultant shall undertake the following tasks in close collaboration with the PIU: i. Preparation of inception report that shows the methodological approach, preparation of stories and

- detailed field plan including field visits and interaction/interview for information collection.
- ii. Carry out field visits for data collection, taking pictures and obtaining video footage, and meeting with relevant farmer groups, individuals and stakeholders, observation/transect walks in the field and preparation of stories. The stories should capture how the individuals/communities have built (where applicable) on the achievements and learning from the projects.

iii. Interview and obtain footage from the following stakeholder groups:

- Beneficiaries/farmers
- Local government officials
- Senior officials in the central government
- IAs
- WB staff
- iv. Collect drone footage as input for the video documentaries.

v. Prepare 5-10 minutes video documentary on agrometeorological information and services for each of the 64 districts in Bangladesh.

- vi. Prepare and develop story book of project success including involvement of relevant stakeholders.
- vii. Prepare 3(three) national video documentary based on above documentaries 10-15 minutes of project success that can help to communicate the policy, relevant stakeholders and ministries, the World Bank internal management, etc.
  - viii. Present a draft success story book to PIU Office for review and validation by a workshop;
  - ix. Submit final version of the story book (English and Bengali);
  - x. Preparation of the final report;
