

Special Agromet bulletin for possible moderately heavy to heavy rainfall from 01-03 November 2020

(Barishal, Barguna, Bhola, Jhalokati, Patuakhali, Pirojpur, Lakshimpur, Noakhali, Feni, Khagrachhari, Rangamati, Bandarban, Chittagong, Cox's Bazar, Bagerhat, Khulna, Satkhira)

Issued Date: 01/11/2020

A low pressure area has formed over central Bay and adjoining North Bay. It is likely to move in a north/north-westerly direction. According to the medium range forecast of Bangladesh Meteorological Department, there is a chance of moderately heavy to heavy rainfall for the above-mentioned districts for the next 03 days (01-03 November 2020).

Subject to the analysis of data obtained from the Bangladesh Meteorological Department, with the approval of the Director General, Department of Agricultural Extension, the following Agromet Advisory have been provided for the above districts:

- Clean the irrigation channel for draining out extra water from the Aman field
- Mature vegetables and aman paddy are 80% ripe, before the rains, collect it and keep them in a safe place.
- Drain out excess water from the crop field.
- Keep drainage clean around the land of vegetables and other rabi crops channels clean to avoid water logging.
- Cover the vegetable seedlings with polythene sheets to protect from damage of rain water.
- Stop sowing seeds of Rabi crop as relay crop.
- Avoid from providing irrigation, fertilizers and pesticides.
- Avoid from sowing seeds and planting seedlings.
- Provide mechanical support to banana & standing vegetables.
- Keep the livestock shed clean and dry
- Maintain a good height of embankment around the pond. If possible, provide net or bamboo chatai around the pond to protect from flowing out fish with excess water.
