Special Agro-met bulletin for possible rainfall from 25-26 February 2022

(For Rangpur, Dinajpur, Kurigram, Nilphamari, Gaibandha, Thakurgaon, Panchagarh, Lalmonirha, Bogura, Chapainawabganj, Joypurhat, Naogaon, Natore, Pabna, Rajshahi, Sirajgonj, Mymensingh, Netrokona, Jamalpur, Sherpur, Habiganj, Moulvibazar, Sunamganj, Sylhet, Dhaka, Gazipur, Kishoreganj, Manikganj, Munshiganj, Narayanganj, Narsindi, Tangail, Faridpur, Gopalganj, Madaripur, Rajbari, Shariatpur)

According to the medium range forecast of Bangladesh Meteorological Department, there is a chance of light to moderate (1-22 mm) rainfall for the next 02 days (25-26 February 2022). There is a possibility of light to moderate rainfall on the above 37 Districts of the country on February 25-26. This type of rainfall can affect crop cultivation and standing crops in the field.

Subject to the analysis of data obtained from the Bangladesh Meteorological Department, with the approval of the Director General, Department of Agricultural Extension, The following special agromet advisory is given for standing crops to minimize the adverse effects of rainfall.

- Avoid application of fertilizer, pesticides and irrigation.
- Harvest matured vegetables, potato, lentil, mustard & horticultural crops and keep it safe and dry place.
- Blast disease may occur in boro paddy and wheat. In case of disease, apply approved
 pesticides for control.
- Keep the drain clean so that water does not accumulate in the Peanuts, wheat, maize, mustard, lentils, vegetables and potato field.
- Arrange for elevated bunding around boro paddy land.
- Provide mechanical support to the standing banana, sugarcane and other horticultural crops
