

## Special agro-met advisories to possible floods for the districts of Lalmonirhat, Nilphamari and northeast parts of Rangpur

## Date of Issue: 03 June, 2022

As per rainfall and river situation summary as on 03 June issued by the BWDB, there is a chance of medium to heavy rainfall at some places of the northern and north-eastern regions of the country including Assam, Meghalaya and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal of India in next 48 hours. In this situation, the Dharla and the Teesta may rise rapidly due to heavy rainfall and flow above their respective danger levels causing a brief flood situation in next 48 hours. As a result, there is a chance of flood condition shortly on the above districts in Bangladesh. The following urgent agromet advisories are issued with the consent of the Director General, Department of Agricultural Extension (DAE):

- 1. Harvest the matured crops immediately.
- 2. Do not sow any crop now.
- 3. Abstain from application of fertilizers, pesticides, irrigation, and land preparation.
- 4. Arrange nets around the ponds/fish farm so that fishes may not come out due to heavy rainfall/flood.
- 5. Keep the livestock in safe places
