Weather Forecast Valid For 72 Hours Commencing 09 AM of 22.04.2024:

Synoptic Situation: Trough of low lies over West Bengal and adjoining area.

Forecast:

Day-1 (commencing 09 AM of 22.04.2024):

Rainfall: Rain/thunder showers accompanied by temporary gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Mymensingh, Chattogram & Sylhet divisions with hails at isolated places. Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country.

Heat wave: Very severe heat wave is sweeping over Pabna & Chuadanga districts. Severe heat wave is sweeping over the districts of Rajshahi, Tangail, Jashore & Kushtia. Mild to moderate heat wave is sweeping over Rangpur, Barishal & Mymensingh divisions and rest parts of Dhaka, Rajshahi & Khluna divisions and the districts of Srimangal & Chandpur and it may continue.

Temperature: Day temperature may fall slightly and night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country. Due to increase of moisture incursion, the discomfort may persists.

Wind direction and speed at Dhaka : West/Northwesterly (08-12) kph.
RH at 06 A.M. of Dhaka : 81%
Today's sunset at Dhaka : 06-23 PM
Tomorrow's sunrise at Dhaka : 05-30 AM

Day-2 (commencing 09 AM of 23.04.2024):

Rainfall: Rain/thunder showers accompanied by temporary gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Sylhet division with hails at isolated places. Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country.

Heat wave: The prevailing heat wave may continue.

Temperature: Day temperature may rise slightly and night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.. Due to increase of moisture incursion, the discomfort may persists.

Day-3 (commencing 09 AM of 24.04.2024):

Rainfall: Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy sky over the country.

Heat wave: The prevailing heat wave may continue.


Temperature: Day and night temperature may rise slightly over the country. Due to increase of moisture incursion, the discomfort may persists.
